

ALLERGEN POLICY

Considering the adverse reactions of some people suffering from food product allergy and intolerance, Nutrafur decided to implement this policy aimed at identifying and managing allergens. This policy applies to all manufacturing processes, manufactured products and raw materials used at Nutrafur facilities.

The substances considered allergens, mentioned in Annex 2 of Regulation 1169/2011, are listed below.

1. Cereals containing gluten, that is: wheat (such as emmer and khorasan wheat), rye, barley, oats, or their hybridized strains and products thereof, except:
 - a. Wheat-based glucose syrups including dextrose;
 - b. Wheat-based maltodextrins;
 - c. Glucose syrups based on barley;
 - d. Cereals used for making distillates, including ethyl alcohol of agricultural origin.
2. Crustaceans and products thereof.
3. Eggs and products thereof.
4. Fish and products thereof.
5. Peanuts and products thereof.
6. Soybeans and products thereof, except:
 - a. fully refined soybean oil and fat (1);
 - b. natural mixed tocopherols (E306), natural D-alpha tocopherol, natural D-alpha tocopherol acetate and natural D-alpha tocopherol succinate from soybean sources;
 - c. vegetable oils derived phytosterols and phytosterol esters from soybean sources;
 - d. plant stanol ester produced from vegetable oil sterols from soybean sources.
7. Milk and products thereof (including lactose), except:
 - a. whey used for making alcoholic distillates, including ethyl alcohol of agricultural origin
 - b. lactitol.

8. Nuts, i.e. almonds (*Amygdalus communis* L.), hazelnuts (*Corylus avellana*), walnuts (*Juglans regia*), cashews (*Anacardium occidentale*), pecan nuts [*Carya illinoensis* (Wangenh.) K. Koch], Brazil nuts (*Bertholletia excelsa*), pistachio nuts (*Pistacia vera*), macadamia nuts or Queensland nuts (*Macadamia ternifolia*), and products thereof, except nuts used for making alcoholic distillates, including ethyl alcohol of agricultural.
9. Celery and products thereof.
10. Mustard and products thereof.
11. Sesame seeds and products thereof
12. Sulfur dioxide and sulfites at concentrations of more than 10 mg/kg or 10 mg/liter expressed as total SO₂ for products ready for consumption or reconstituted according to manufacturer instructions.
13. Lupin and products thereof.
14. Mollusks and products thereof.

With the aim to identify and manage allergenic substances, the specifications provided by our suppliers are assessed in order to identify the potential presence of these substances and the need to implement special work processes preventing the contamination of manufactured products with allergenic substances.

Existing production processes at Nutrafur S.A. facilities do not involve the use of substances classified as allergens. If due to logistical reasons of the Frutarom Group it were necessary to store any of these substances, the following guidelines would be followed:

- Products shall be stored in a designated warehouse area for non-vegetal raw material, intermediate and end products. These products shall always be palletized, hermetically sealed and placed on the lower shelf.
- It is not allowed to manipulate any product containing allergens. This includes the prohibition to sample for analysis purposes. If samples were needed, they would be taken by the supplier outside Nutrafur facilities.
- Allergenic substances stored in the warehouse shall have a proper label indicating the product does contain allergens.

This policy applies to all company workers, who are aware of the relevance of complying with product storage norms and ensuring the implementation of Good Manufacturing Practices in terms of hygiene.
